Logline:

After Caer appears to Aengus one night, he grows increasingly lovesick. He and his family are desperate to reunite them before Aenqus's condition significantly worsens and he dies from loneliness.

Synopsis:

AENGUS YOUNG and his half-brothers BODB DERG, CERMAIT and AED are summoned to their father, DAGDA. Dagda alongside BOANN, Aengus's birth mother, addresses their sons and rewards Aengus's brothers with land to govern over, leaving nothing to Aengus. Aengus protests, but Dagda explains that Aengus does nothing but drink and charm women, rather than helping citizens and defeating enemies as his brothers have done. Aengus's brothers mock Aengus stating that the god of love has no one who truly loves him.

Aengus is furious at them all and storms off while his brothers mockingly blow kisses. Boann motions for BRIGIT, his half-sister, to comfort him. Aengus is bitter and states that he will never be what his father wants him to be and that every woman he encounters only love him for his youth and beauty. Brigit comforts him, but Aengus leaves, stating he will do what he does best.

Before dawn Aengus arrives in his chambers in a drunken daze. He sings to his birds and quickly falls quiet, looking at the pair lovingly. Suddenly an apparition of a beautiful girl appears, startling Aengus. After a brief conversation Aengus hesitantly offers her his hand. She reaches out, but the morning sunlight fills the room and she disappears. Aengus collapses into anguish.

Brigit visits Aengus. She gasps at his pale completion and demands he sees a physician. He argues that he is fine. Brigit is worried and sends a messenger to Boann about his condition. Boann arrives with FERGNE, a respected physician. Aengus is hesitant. Fergne states that Aengus is love sick. Aengus hesitantly tells them about the girl.

Boann pleads Dagda to help Aengus. Dagda argues with Boann, but eventually reveals that he knows of the girl Aengus had seen and that she is Caer, daughter of Ethal Anbuil. Dagda goes on to say that Ethal Anbuil, king of Sid, is too powerful to fight and too stubborn to listen. Boann convinces Dagda to try and help Aengus.

Dagda takes Aengus to a lake near Sid. Dagda warns Aengus that Caer is there, but they can't have any interaction with her in order not to anger Ethal Anbuil. There are many girls wearing silver necklaces. Cear is there and Dagda is forced to lead Aengus away. Aengus becomes weak and Dagda struggles to comfort him.

Dagda visits King Ailill and Queen Maeve and hesitantly asks for them to help get Caer. He tells them that Aengus has fallen in love with her. Ailill and Maeve explain that they would have to go to war to get Caer. A messenger is sent to Ethal Anbuail. The messenger returns and quotes that Ethal Anbuail will not give his daughter to the son of Dagda.

Ailill and Dagda brought their armies and destroyed Sid. Ethal Anbuail reveals that he can't give Caer to Angus because she is currently in the form of a swan and will leave the land and fly soon. Ailill and Dagda convince Ethal to tell them that she will not return for a full year.

Dagda sends a messenger via Aengus's birds. He tells Aengus to hurry to the lake, Loch Bel Dracon, as Caer will leave. Dagda goes on to say that he is proud of Aengus for following his heart as that is what Dagda had done for Boann when he was younger.

Aengus arrives at the lake and finds many white swans with silver necklaces. Aengus stands at the edge of the lake and calls out to Caer. She comes to him and makes Aengus promise to let her return to the water when she wishes. Aengus agrees and Caer walks with him around the lake. Aengus then lets her return to the water. He watches her swim out for a moment before he jumps into the water and emerges as a swan himself. Caer and Aengus dance and swim together. The pair take flight, flying over lands and castles.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - THRONE ROOM - MORNING

BODB DERG, CERMAIT and AED march into the throne room and kneel before king DAGDA and queen BOANN. Boann quickly looks around.

BOANN

Where is young Aengus?

BODB DERG suddenly rises.

BODB DERG

My queen, your son was at the market place the last we heard of his whereabouts.

Boann frowns and turns towards Dagda.

DAGDA

Lets not bother and continue.

Boann signals and motions to Dagda's sons to rise.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

My sons, I've heard of your great--

AENGUS suddenly bolts into the throne room.

AENGUS

I'm here, I'm here!

Boann smiles as Aengus stands in line besides his brothers.

BOANN

Ah, my son. Your tardiness is something that must be fixed.

Dagda frowns.

DAGDA

My boy, don't be late again.

Aengus gives a shy smile. Dagda sighs.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

I've heard of your great success in far lands and most of you have wives and are planning a family. I have decided to award you, your own lands to govern over and develop.

Bobd Derg, Cermait, Aed and Aengus all smile.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

My eldest, Bobd Derg I award you Laketown, already populated by citizens.

BODB DERG

Thank you father.

DAGDA

Cermait, I award you Phoenix Valley.

CERMAIT

Thank you father.

DAGDA

And Aed, I award you the Wild Planes south of Sid.

AED

Thank you very much father. I will ensure the Wild Planes will forever supply us with the strongest horses.

DAGDA

My sons, your mother will be very proud of you, may this bring her joy in the heavens.

Boann momentarily looks away, almost ashamed. Bobd Derg steps forward.

BODB DERG

Father, mother is always overjoyed with each breathe we take.

DAGDA

Thank you my sons, you are all dismissed.

AENGUS

Wait what about me?

The room falls silent. Dagda quickly frowns.

DAGDA

Aengus, you have no right to speak out of line like that.

AENGUS

Sorry father, but why have my brothers

received such gifts and I have not received anything?

DAGDA

I do recall mentioning their successes resulting in these rewards.

Boann lowers her gaze from Aengus. Bodb Derg leans towards Aengus.

BODB DERG

Maybe be it is because your mother said no--

DAGDA

Bobd Derg, stop spitting nonsense.

Bodb Derg straightens. Dagda rubs his temples.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

Aengus, you need to understand that rewards are given to those who work, as your brothers have in both the battles they have taken part in and manual labor in this city.

AENGUS

Then why summon me and make me watch you reward them?

DAGDA

To encourage you to do better than drinking and flirting with the local women.

Aengus's face turns red and he lowers his gaze. Bodb Derg, Cermait and Aed start snickering. Dagda rolls his eyes.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

My young boy, you need to make something of your life. Find a girl to settle down with or join the army.

Boann gently brushes Dagda's arm. She gently shakes her head.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

Not the army, but anything other than drinking and the women.

Aengus frowns.

AENGUS

What if I can't resist the women and the alcohol?

DAGDA

Then be prepared to live as a common folk in the streets than a prince in a palace in the future.

Aengus is shocked, Bobd Derg bursts into laughter.

BODB DERG

Forgive me father, but Aengus hasn't worked a day in his life and I also doubt that he will settle down.

Aengus jumps up with clenched fists.

AENGUS

What makes you think I can't settle down with a girl?

BODB DERG

Aengus, you're the god of love, women fall for you wherever you go, but they are only attracted to your beauty and will never truly love you in both soul and mind.

Aengus is speechless. Cermait and Aen laugh.

CERMAIT

I guess Aengus is going to be a commoner.

Bodb Derg, Cermait, Aed and Dagda laugh. Boann stands up, silencing the room.

BOANN

Enough of this.

AENGUS

Mother please don't stand up for me. I should be able to handle myself.

Boann's gaze softens at the sight of Aengus. She slowly settles back in her seat. Dagda glances at Boann and back at his sons.

DAGDA

Perhaps, that is enough. You are all

DAGDA (CONT'D)

dismissed.

Aengus is the first to turn and storm out of the throne room with his brother slowly doing the same.

EXT - THE GOLDEN CITY - CORRIDOR - MORNING

Aengus leans over the banister, looking out over the city. He sighs and begins to hum in a gentle tune.

BRIGIT (O.S.)

Are you okay?

Aengus quickly turns around and sees BRIGIT.

AENGUS

Oh Brigit, it's just you.

Brigit slowly approaches Aengus, swaying gently.

BRIGIT

How you feeling after that?

Brigit motions her head towards the throne room.

AENGUS

You saw it?

Aengus runs his hands through his hair.

BRIGIT

You would have to be deaf not to have heard it.

Brigit lifts herself and sits on the banister. Brigit giggles to herself.

AENGUS

I'm guessing mom sent you?

BRIGIT

She was very worried and told me to make sure that you were alright.

AENGUS

Yes I'm fine, it was just an overwhelming moment. The anger and frustration of it all was just building.

BRIGIT

Anyone would have been overwhelmed if they were just told they were a waste of space. I can understand your frustration, it was unfair of Dagda to make you watch your brothers get rewarded.

Aengus sighs and leans back.

AENGUS

Step brothers... I guess it really did sound like I was a waste of space, just here with nothing to offer.

Brigit playfully hits Aengus's arm.

BRIGIT

Don't be silly I was only joking. I am sure that you will find a lovely girl who would want to spend the rest of her life with you.

AENGUS

As much as I want to believe it, that sounds impossible. Women only love me because I'm beautiful not because they see a future with me.

Brigit laughs.

BRIGIT

That doesn't sound that bad!

Aengus turns to her.

AENGUS

Becoming a commoner doesn't sound that bad either. I will still flirt with women. I would just need work to pay for my drinks and meals.

Brigit frowns and shakes her head.

BRIGIT

Aengus, you can't possibly believe that you are okay with becoming a commoner and be kicked out of the palace. First of all the alcohol you drink is far more expensive than you think it is and secondly, no woman BRIGIT (CONT'D)

will want to settle with a drunk that used to be a prince.

Aengus slowly walks away from the banister and Brigit follows him.

AENGUS

I guess I will have to do what I do best.

Brigit laughs.

BRIGIT

And what would that be?

AENGUS

Drink and bed women!

Aengus suddenly takes off running through the corridor.

BRIGIT

Oh my god Aengus no! That is the complete opposite thing you should do right now.

Aengus laughs and waves goodbye to Brigit.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - CASTLES PRIVATE BAR - EVENING

Aengus is drinking and has two BEAUTIFUL GIRLS at his sides. The bar's BAND is playing fast pace music. Aengus turns and kisses one of the girls. LUGUS throws his arms over Aengus's shoulders, laughing.

LUGUS

Oh Angus! Please make me your woman.

Aengus playfully shoves Lugus off him.

AENGUS

Stop it my friend, you are embarrassing me in front of these beautiful women.

The women smile awkwardly at Lugus.

LUGUS

Oh piss-posh.

Lugus grabs Aengus and pulls him away from the women.

LUGUS

Excuse us ladies.

Aengus tries to break free, but Lugus locks Aengus against him.

AENGUS

Lugus you brute, I was going to take them home.

Lugus laughs and hands Aengus another drink.

LUGUS

And then what? Sleep with them. You will wake with them missing the next morning, return to this bar and repeat the process?

Aengus falls silent and dramatically looks back towards the women.

AENGUS

But isn't that Heaven?

Lugus playfully hits Aengus on the head.

LUGUS

Your brothers would gut you if they heard that this is how you describe the place where their mother rests.

Aengus takes a long sip from his drink.

AENGUS

She wasn't my mother.

LUGUS

Still, you need to show respect in order to receive it. Same thing with women. Give them respect and they show you respect... that is usually how you will know what girl will be yours.

Lugus takes another cup and finishes it.

AENGUS

Isn't your wife one of the most feared and high ranked women in the army?

Lugus spits out his drink and collapses in a fit of laughter.

LUGUS

Yes! Yes! She could cut off my head and I would certainly let her! But hell, I love her.

Aengus's laughter suddenly grows quiet.

AENGUS

I envy you Lugus. I long to be happy with someone. To spend the rest of my life with someone, preferable, away from this city.

Lugus pulls himself up.

LUGUS

Why? What is wrong with the women in this city?

Aengus glances at all the women in the bar and smiles.

AENGUS

My friend, there is nothing wrong with the women in this city. What I meant was that I would prefer a woman from somewhere else. Where she will never have to know about me having been with nearly every woman in this city.

LUGUS

No. No, young Aengus. Love is built on honesty. If you ever find--

Aengus frowns at Lugus, Lugus gives an awkward laugh and continues.

LUGUS (CONT'D)

I mean, when you find a girl you should be honest. If she leaves you, then she wasn't meant for you, but if she stays...

Lugus leans towards Aengus.

LUGUS (CONT'D)

(whispering)

Then, Aengus, she is the one for you.

Aengus's eyes widen.

AENGUS

You really believe that Lugus?

Lugus shrugs.

LUGUS

Yes of course. Any woman who stays, after hearing how many women you have been with, must be crazy enough to marry you.

Lugus laughs and Aengus laughs with him.

AENGUS

My friend, you are an asshole.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AENGUS'S HOME - EVENING

Aengus stubbles through the front door in a drunken daze. He struggles to close his door and wanders over to his pair of phoenix birds. The birds starts singing to Aengus.

AENGUS

Such a beautiful song.

Aengues watches the birds sing together, they appears to be dancing. Aengus's smile suddenly fades. He sighs and very carefully approaches his birds and strokes them.

AENGUS

Not needing love for so long and suddenly it is something I feel I can't live without.

The birds chirps and Aengus smiles.

AENGUS

You want a song?

The birds chirp repeatedly and flap their wings. Aengus laughs.

AENGUS

Okay Shhhh... I'll sing.

The birds fall silent and Aengus smiles. He takes a deep breath and begins to sing in octaves. It is a song of sadness and loneliness.

CAER (O.S.)

What a heartbreaking song.

Aengus, startled, abruptly stands up. Suddenly, a very beautiful girl, coated in water floats towards the birds. Aengus is speechless.

CAER

These poor birds will die after hearing such a sad song.

She turns towards Aengus.

CAER (CONT'D)

Why are you so sad?

Aengus quickly shakes his head and stares at her.

AENGUS

Caer floats closer to him.

CAER

But that song, it sounded like a man wailing for his dead lover.

Aengus's face turns red.

AENGUS

I have no dead lover!

CAER

Perhaps your lover left you?

Aengus immediately turns away from Caer.

AENGUS

What? No. I... I have no lover.

CAER

Then crying out for a lover?

Aengus falls quiet and sighs.

AENGUS

Yeah, that might be it.

CAER

You must be lonely at night?

AENGUS

No. I mean I don't often spend the nights alone.

Caer laughs.

CAER

Then why sing like that if you are not completely alone?

Aengus pouts. Folds his arms over his chest.

CAER

Don't act like a child. You're a grown man.

AENGUS

Funny. No one really treats me like one.

Cear moves closer to Aengus, looking curious.

CAER

Why? Are you retarded or something?

AENGUS

I'm not retarded. Just the youngest of my siblings. By the way you should not call people retarded, it is rude.

CAER

What if you are retarded, then what?

AENGUS

But, I'm not retarded.

CAER

But what if you are?

AENGUS

What in gods name are you doing. I just said that I'm not. Are you deaf or something.

Caer falls quiet.

CAER

Now, that, was rude.

Aengus stares at Caer in disbelief. Caer cracks a laugh and Aengus laughs with her.

AENGUS

Good grief you are strange.

Caer looks down at her hands and laughs.

CAER

Yes, I'm here through dream pool. Everything about this interaction is strange.

Aengus suddenly straightens up.

AENGUS

Wait you're real?

Caer cocks her head to the side, inquisitively.

CAER

Yes?

Aengus jumps forwards towards her.

AENGUS

My lady I apologize I thought you were a drunken delusion.

Caer pauses and bursts into laughter.

CAER

My goodness you are such a silly man. I'm in a dream pool. I heard your song and came to investigate.

Aengus blinks in disbelief.

AENGUS

You are in a dream pool? Where?

CAER

I usually don't use a dream pool to teleport my conscious, but I wanted to try it.

AENGUS

Please give me your name my lady.

Caer glances around the room. She looks at Aengus.

CAER

No. I don't think so.

Aengus laughs.

AENGUS

You are tormenting me.

CAER

Nope, just teasing you.

Cear smiles at Aengus.

CAER (CONT'D)

I think I like you. You are very funny.

Aengus looks at her, hopeful.

AENGUS

Please, give me your name.

Cear opens her mouth to speak and suddenly sees the sunlight slowly rising. As the light pours into the room Caer disappears. She looks longingly at Aengus. Aengus's face turns into terror.

AENGUS

No!

CAER

Aengus jumps up and dives to embrace Caer. She disappears in his arms. Aengus collapses onto the ground staring into his empty hands.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AENGUS HOME - MORNING

Brigit opens Aengus's door. She frowns confused.

BRIGIT

Aengus! Are you home, apparently you didn't join mom for breakfast.

Brigit slowly walks through the house. She looks at the birds and the birds are staring at the balcony doors. Brigit frowns and hesitantly tip-toes towards the balcony doors.

BRIGIT (CONT'D)

Aengus?

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AENGUS'S HOME - BALCONY - MORNING

Brigit opens the balcony doors and sees Aengus staring directing into the morning sun. His completion has become

unnaturally pale. Brigit, concerned, embraces Aengus.

BRIGIT (CONT'D)

Aengus! What has happened? Are you sick? My lord how much did you drink last night?

Aengus sighs.

AENGUS

I didn't drink that much.

BRIGIT

You are sick Aengus.

Aengus gently pushes Brigit to the side and returns inside. Brigit follows closely behind him with a concerned expression.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AENGUS HOME - MORNING

Aengus moves to his birds and starts stroking them.

AENGUS

I'm am not sick.

BRIGIT

You clearly are. You are as white as a ghost. I will call a physician imedietly.

Brigit quickly rushes for a pen and paper. Aengus quickly grabs the pen from her.

AENGUS

Brigit, I am not sick and I don't need to see a physician.

Brigit looks at Aengus. She frowns suddenly very worried.

BRIGIT

You used to care a lot more about your health. What is wrong?

She opens her arms to embrace him. He leans into the hug.

AENGUS

I'm not ready to accept the cause of my illness.

Brigit frowns and gently pulls away from Aengus and looks

into his eyes tenderly.

BRIGIT

You know what has caused this illness?

Aengus looks at Brigit tenderly and nods.

BRIGIT (CONT'D)

I'm sorry brother, but I can't sit by while you are in such a state.

Aengus gives a smile.

AENGUS

Please try.

Aengus suddenly turns serious, catching Brigit off guard.

AENGUS (CONT'D)

And don't tell our mother.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AENGUS'S HOME - MID DAY

There is a sudden knock at Aengus's door. He opens the door to see Boann standing proudly at the door, with Brigit avoiding Aengus's gaze and FERGNE who extends his hand.

FERGNE

Good day young prince. I have been informed of your sudden illness and have been tasked to remedy it.

AENGUS

What?

Aengus is speechless. He glances at Brigit and frowns. Boann steps inside to embrace Aengus.

BOANN

My son why have you not informed me of this illness.

AENGUS

Mother I am not that sick.

She ignores him and gently pushes Aengus away too look at him. She gasps.

BOANN (CONT'D)

My heavens you are white as a ghost.

She looks at Fergne and points at Aengus.

BOANN (CONT'D)

Please cure this.

Fergne nods. He pulls out a bag filled with tools. Aengus's eyes widen at the tools.

AENGUS

No thank you I am quite alright.

BOANN

Nonsense, look at you.

Aengus rolls his eyes at him mother. Brigit leans towards Aengus's ear.

BRIGIT

I'm so sorry brother, I was concerned about your health.

AENGUS

You should be concerned about you're health when I get my hands on you.

BRIGIT

I did say sorry.

Brigit gives a wicked smile.

BRIGIT (CONT'D)

But I will enjoy seeing a few needles impaling your skin.

Aengus's eyes widen.

AENGUS

Don't you--

BOANN

Fergne is the highest respected physician for miles.

Boan smiles sweetly at Brigit and Aengus.

BOANN (CONT'D)

Don't worry Aengus we will cure this illness quickly.

Boann turns to Brigit and motions Brigit to join her out of Fergne's way. Fergne steps in front of Aengus and smiles.

AENGUS

What tests are you going to do?

Fergne smiles again.

FERGNE

For now, nothing, I'm just going to study your movements.

Aengus is confused as Fergne stares at him. Aengus frowns staring back at Fergne. There is a long silence and Aengus instinctively looks away.

FERGNE

You are lovesick.

Aengus straightens, immediately defensive.

AENGUS

I am not lovesick.

Aengus glances at Brigit and Boann anxiously. Fergne slowly shakes his head.

FERGNE

I'm an expert in my field. You are lovesick.

Aengus stares at Fergne, horrified.

FERGNE (CONT'D)

Who is she?

Aengus looks and Boann and Brigit as they look on in surprise. Aengus hesitates.

AENGUS

A girl, she was in a dream pool and heard me singing.

Boann and Brigit are speechless.

BOANN

There are only two existing dream pools on record in our books.

Boann looks around the room and approaches Aengus.

BOANN (CONT'D)

Aengus what is her name. We need to find her and cure your lovesick.

Aengus drops his dead. A single tear traces down his face. Boann's expression falls.

BOANN (CONT'D)

What did she look like?

Aengus pauses for a moment.

AENGUS

She was the most beautifull girl I had ever seen.

Aengus stands up almost reliving the moment.

AENGUS (CONT'D)

Her skin was silver like the moon her hair was long and golden like the sun. Her eyes...

Aengus pauses thinking back.

AENGUS (CONT'D)

Her eyes were as green and wild as the untamed forests.

Brigit sheds a tear, watching as Aengus's colour slowly fades away.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - ROYAL CHAMBERS - EVENING

Boann enters the room and sees Dagda reading letters'. She takes a deep breath and hesitantly approaches Dagda.

BOANN

My love.

Dagda smiles and turns to Boann.

DAGDA

Yes, love?

Boann takes a seat near Dagda and sighs.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

Are you about to tell me about Aengus?

BOANN

You know about that already?

Dagda smiles sweetly at Boann.

DAGDA

I know about everything in this city.

BOANN

Will you help?

Dagda frowns and stares and Boann.

DAGDA

Why would I help? You and him heard what I said that morning. He needs to clean up, stop drinking, stop with all the local women and be of use to this city and its people.

Boan stands up suddenly offended.

BOANN

He is not as an awful person as you make him out to be. He is just being young--

DAGDA

And stupid. My love imagine how many children he has unknowingly fathered. It is a miracle no woman has claimed that a child is his.

BOANN

Stop speaking about him like that,

Boann becomes emotional and Dagda sighs. He gently holds Boann's hand.

DAGDA

I'm sorry my love, but I'm not going to help him when there is a chance he will go back to his lifestyle before.

BOANN

He won't. You would believe it if you were there and heard the way he spoke about her. Her skin and hair... it was beautiful and I honestly believe that she could change him and make him better once we find her.

Dagda clenches his fists.

DAGDA

I can't help you find her.

Boann is shocked and angry.

BOANN

After everything you heard and what I'm telling you. You still won't do anything to help find this girl.

DAGDA

I can't help you find her because I know who she is.

Boann falls silent. Dadga gets up and sets the letters down. He is exhausted and stressed. Boann stares at Dagda, patiently waiting for him to explain.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

White skin, golden hair, green eyes and had access to a dream pool.

He sighs.

DAGDA (CONT'D)

Her name is Caer and she is the only daughter of Ethal Anbuail, King of Sid.

Boann's mouth falls ajar. Dagda lets out a stressful chuckle.

BOANN

What is your relationship like with Ethal Anbuail?

DAGDA

Not good unfortunately. He can be dangerous as he has a strong army capable of defeating our own. He also has a very bad temper.

Boann looks worried.

BOANN

So what does this mean?

DAGDA

It means that I need to find strong friends in order to pressurize Ethal Anbuail to willingly let his daughter be with Aengus with no future retaliation from him and his army.

Boann jumps up suddenly happy.

BOANN

You will help Aengus?

Dagda looks at Boann lovingly.

DAGDA

I will help on the condition that I see a change in Aengus.

INT - THE GOLDEN CITY - ROYAL STABLES - MORNING

After 9 months Aengus hasn't had a drop of alcohol or had spoken to another local woman ever since seeing Caer. His health had slowly worsened as colour in his skin, hair and eyes has dulled. Aengus has been seen helping the local businesses and has been working in the royal stables tending to the horses.

Dagda walks into the stables and sees Aengus grooming one of the horses.

DAGDA

Aengus?

Aengus momentarily stops grooming and kneels before Dagda. Dagda motions Aengus to rise and Aengus resumes grooming.

AENGUS

Good morning Dagda.

Dagda nods his head.

AENGUS

AENGUS

Dagda runs a hand through his hair and sighes.

DAGDA

Aengus looks at the ground and smiles.

AENGUS

Then I do love Caer.

INT - CONNACHT - THRONE ROOM - AFTERNOON

MAEVE

Maeve nods, understandingly.

MAEVE

You want our help to pressure him into willingly let her be with your son.

DAGDA

And possibly prevent him from lashing out in the future.

MAEVE

She looks lovingly at Ailill and turns back to Dagda.

MAEVE (CONT'D)

We offer our help.

Maeve falls silent and waits for Dagda's response. Dagda takes in a confident breath and steps forward proudly.

DAGDA

If you are asking me if I would shed blood to ensure the happiness of my son? After he endured such a heartache that he has lost life in his skin, hair and eyes, then yes. I would slaughter whoever I have to, to make that happen.

Silence falls in the room. Maeve expression softens.

MAEVE

AILILL

Whatever you choose, my love.

Maeve smiles and turns back to Dagda.

MAEVE

We will help you and march with you into Sid.

Ailill nods his head.

EXT - SID - AFTERNOON

Just outside Sid's walls Dagda and Maeve march forwards with their two armies following behind them. They stop just outside the gates. Maeve motions a messenger on a horse and the messenger enters the gates.

MAEVE

I have made it very clear that this is his final warning to negotiate with us or be stormed.

Dagda frowns and looks seriously towards Sid.

DAGDA

I don't think he will listen. He would rather have people die than step down to anyone.

MAEVE

I have dealt with proud men before.

DAGDA

Oh really? How did that go?

Maeve smiled.

MAEVE

I seized his city and married him.

Dagda laughs.

DAGDA

You are still very amusing.

MAEVE

I'm always amusing.

Dagda notices movement. He motions Maeve to watch as the messenger approaches. The messenger approaches, however he didn't look hopeful.

MAEVE

What has he decided?

MESSENGER

Your majesty, he... he has refused.

Maeve clenches her fists. She turns to Dagda, now concerned.

DAGDA

I still want to do this.

Maeve sighs but gives a stong nod. She turns to face the troops.

MAEVE

My warriors! Ethal Anbuail has refused the peaceful path! Now we shall show him out strength so that he may never go against our reign!

The two armies rhythmically hit their shields and arms. Maeve raises her sword and charges into battle with Dagda by her side. They storm through the city walls and battle with Sid's army.

ETHAL ANBUAIL

Dagda stares down at Ethal Anbuail.

DAGDA

He is no longer a young brat.

Ethal Anbuail laughs and sits down.

ETHAL ANBUAIL

You expect me to believe that?

DAGDA

ETHAL ANBUAIL

That is not my problem.

Dagda clenches his fits and threateningly steps forward.

DAGDA

Ethal Anbuail! It is fate. Allow this and let there be peace.

Ethal Anbuail bites at his nails nervously.

ETHAL ANBUAIL

I can't let that happen.

DAGDA

Why?

ETHAL ANBUAIL

Because she has power of her own, her human year is about to end and I don't have the power to make her stay and be with Aengus.

Dagda is shocked.

DAGDA

What do you mean?

Ethal Anbuil looks at Dagda understandingly.

ETHAL ANBUAIL

If it is fated for my Caer to be with Aengus then you will have to wait another year--

Dagda's expression falls to worry.

DAGDA

My son might not have a year.

ETHAL ANBUAIL

The you must hurry to the lake, south from here. She will soon take the form of a swan and leave these lands for a year.

Dagda bolts towards the throne room doors.

DAGDA

Maeve ensure a peace treaty is signed!

Dagda leaves.

EXT - THE GOLDEN CITY - AFTERNOON

DAGDA

GUARD

DAGDA

DAGDA

AENGUS

CAER

AENGUS

CAER

AENGUS

CAER

AENGUS

CAER

AENGUS
